Pastor's Report

First Communion classes were held for 4 students with their first communion happening Nov 17th with each student surrounded by family members.

Advent planning is happening. The sanctuary will be decorated on Dec 1st following church services. Council members and congregation members will be decorating.

- D. Audit of Books this will be done Dec 5th

New Business

- A. Ecumenical Service Volunteers are needed for ushering and serving in other ways for this community service being held at GLC. Janice will be a greeter and usher. Parish Fellowship (Kristen) and Stewardship (Susie) will assist with asking members to provide/serve food following the service. Pastor Carter will provide a roaster of chili. Other churches will also provide food items for the meal.
- B. Decorating for Christmas This will happen following worship on December 1st with the church council and church members. Last year, this took approximately an hour.
- C. Committee Reports

Lay Ministry Report Funeral Committee is being put together with members who will take scheduled turns planning/organizing funerals. Information was shared with council of what it entails to organize a funeral so that we can encourage people to consider being part of this very important and caring committee to provide funerals for our members and their families.

Properties Ryer explained some issues with rugs not staying in place in the narthex and will keep us updated. Winter is coming, snow removal is planned. GLC has a small hand held carpet cleaner, Ryer is looking into a full size carpet cleaner and will report back.

Worship and Music Several services are planned for the coming weeks.

Stewardship Susie also oversees the Lefse making which will happen Dec 1st, 2nd, 3rd to be used for the GLC bake Sale. Celebration Sunday meal is being planned for Dec 8th as part of the Stewardship for All Seasons as a thank you to the congregation for our responses of giving. Mission of the Month recipients have been determined for coming year. Additional items were included as part of the agenda.


