Council Meeting - December 17, 2024

Present: Tom, Susie, Ryer, Darcie, Pastor Carter, Stephanie, Megan, Dave, Janice (via FaceTime)

Darcie brought the meeting to order at 6:38 PM Pastor Carter opened the meeting with a devotion and prayer

Review of November minutes - motion, Tom; second, Susie

Pastor's Report

Pastor Carter had nothing new to report. What he had is discussed in the business section.

Treasurer's Review of Income and Expense

November Offering - \$23,285.19 YTD Offering - \$207,318.09 November Expenses - \$17,741.13 YTD Total Expenses - \$ 253,833.31 YTD Total Income - \$237,892.76

Unfinished Business:

A. Stewardship for All Seasons - The campaign was very successful, bringing in 95 pledge cards totaling \$56,006.10, adding 8 new giving units that were previously giving \$0, and reporting only 2 of the cards giving less.

Audit of the Books - The committee has met and gathered all the information needed. They are working on finding a day to come in to do a full audit.

New Business:

Committee Reports

A. Education Committee - Sunday School was held on Sunday, December 15th. The Program went well.

Lay Ministry - The committee held the Christmas bake sale on Saturday, December 7th. They raised \$2,000 and donated the funds to a few local charities and to some areas at Grafton Lutheran.

Family Leave Recommendations

The Executive Committee performed Pastor Carter's performance evaluation and looked at the current leave policy. The following recommendations were made and presented to the council:

- The GLC Employee Handbook should be reviewed. We recommend that the incoming President appoint a committee to compare the handbook with the ELCA recommendations to suggest appropriate revisions moving forward. This committee could also update binders for the council to inform incoming council members.
- B. The Pastor's request for eight weeks of paternity leave should be approved. The council has overwhelmingly expressed this approval as well. To accomplish this, the following recommendations are made:
- a. It is recommended that 4 weeks paternity leave be given
- b. It is recommended that he be allowed to carry over his unused vacation time this year only for the purpose of using it towards his paternity leave
- c. After the application of four weeks of paternity leave and the use of vacation time otherwise lost, Pastor Carter can allocate any remaining leave between medical and vacation time
- d. Pastor Carter can use his days at his discretion. His current plan is to not take them all at once. These recommendations are for this Pastor, and this child, and are not to be considered a new policy moving forward.

A motion was made to approve the recommendations by Tom; 2nd - Megan

Budget

If the December offering comes in as projected, we will be at budget for the 2024 year. Due to parishioners pledging more offerings, the 2025 budget has increased. The following items were recommended by the Executive Committee:

- A. Salary increases for office administration, worship custodian, and visitation ministry
- B. New item budgeted minister part time added Additional money allocated to youth instead of taking from dedicated funds

Ryer made a motion to approve to submit the budget to congregation at the annual meeting; 2nd Megan

Offering on Non-Communion Sundays/Offering Practices - Council members will sign up on Non-Communion Sundays to take care of the offering. Two people will be required to collect, seal in a tamper proof bag, and sign off on offerings each Sunday.


