GLC Council Meeting – October 22, 2024

Present: Janice, Darcie, Bobbie, Megan, Dave, Ryer, Stephanie, Susie, Kristen, Tom, Pastor Carter Darcie brought the meeting to order at 6:34 PM Pastor Carter opened the meeting with a devotion and prayer

Review of September minutes - motion, Tom; second, Kristen

Pastor's Report:

Pastoral Care - Over the past couple months there have been many illnesses, diagnoses, and death. Pastor Carter reminded us that pastoral care shows up in different ways and has many different looks. A special thank you to Ryer Stark, Jay Sevigny, and Preston Thiele for their assistance in bringing and returning our entire altar area for Chad Demers' funeral.

Confirmation - 8 students (7 juniors, 1 senior) were confirmed on October 20. Their prepared faith statements included a look into who God is to us and what God's plan is. GLC typically has 4 confirmation teachers (2 teachers per class), but we only have 2 for 8th and 9th grade as Pastor Carter was unable to find 4. Thank you to Dawnielle Coffman and Carissa Klug for their willingness to teach.

Sunday School - A survey will go out this fall regarding how Sunday School could best happen at GLC. Many churches in our area are changing how their Sunday School looks and have found success.

Online Worship - We continue to have a strong presence during our online worship. Pastor Carter shared a couple of recent donations that were generated through our online streaming. Marie, a member from Pastor Carter's former call, sent \$1,000 for our broadcasting fund. She wrote, "Grafton Lutheran - you are a blessing to me. I enjoy your services and Pastor Carter every Sunday. I know him personally and have a high respect for him from the past. God's blessings to you all." Also last week, GLC received a \$1,200 offering from a member who left in the 1970s and has recently "rejoined the congregation' via our livestream.

A draft of a Sabbatical Policy using the ELCA guidelines was created by the Executive Committee and brought to Council for review. A motion by Dave and second by Ryer tabled the discussion to the next meeting.

Audit of the Books - The Audit committee will be meeting with Pastor Carter. He will ask if they can have a report available prior to the annual meeting

Parental Leave - The Executive Committee put together recommendations for a parental leave policy using ELCA guidelines. They presented recommendations to the Council. Dave moved to table parental leave until the next meeting.

The Council and Pastor Carter are working on staff performance reviews.


